

How to participate in a Twitter Chat

Find below a few guidelines for a Twitter Chat in case helpful.

- The co-hosts (@GAFSPfund, @ActionAidUSA, @AsianFarmers) will pose all questions with 'Q1' 'Q2' etc. at the beginning, please start your answer with 'A1' 'A2'... Questions will be posted every 5 minutes.
- To save time, prepare your answers in advance so you can copy/paste them into Twitter. Make sure they are less than 280 characters.
- Feel free to send more than one answer! You can also pose your own questions in your responses the Twitter Chat questions .
- Include #WomenEndingHunger in each tweet and also add #IWD2022 and #InvestFarmtoFork if space allows.
- If you would like to see what other people are contributing to the chat, please open another browser tab and follow #WomenEndingHunger.
- To maximize your responses during the chat, provide links to resources on your website or a recent news article, etc. Have a few of these already identified before the chat to save time.
- If you find someone has picked up on something you said, you can respond to them directly or direct the question to the co-hosts (@GAFSPfund, @ActionAidUSA, @AsianFarmers).
- Ask others in your organization to engage on their personal accounts – when users see a range of handles, not just those of organizations, they may be more inclined to take part.
- Would you like the audience to take action? Think about how you would like to sign off the chat, e.g. "Thank you, for more info visit xxx"
