It is with great pleasure that we bring to you a proposal for financing from the Global Agriculture and Food Security Programme (GAFSP) for the Smallholder Commercialisation Programme, on behalf of the Government of Sierra Leone.

The Government has decided to prioritise the Smallholder Commercialisation Programme (SCP) over the next five years under the National Sustainable Agriculture Development Plan (NSADP), which was launched as Sierra Leone's Compact under the Comprehensive Africa Agriculture Development Programme (CAADP) process. On 21 May, the Presidential Task Force on Agriculture, the country's peak sector coordinating body, fully endorsed the SCP Investment Plan as constituting the National Agricultural Investment Plan (NAIP) under CAADP.

Sierra Leone's submission to the GAFSP Steering Committee is based on this plan for the sector, which has been the product of extensive consultation with stakeholders and development partners.
